

Rubric: Creating a *Start Here* Module

Description:

A *start here* module in the content section of the course provides learners with an introduction to the course, the course environment, the course tools, and the course policies and procedures. It sets the foundation and structure of the course procedures, policies, and expectations.

Alignment:

This rubric would provide guidance on the elements to include in a *start here* module as well as permit learners to self-assess or to have others assess their performance. In addition, the tool could be used by an instructor to provide feedback on the adequacy of the *start here* module.
